

Assoc. Prof. Dr. Pham, Bao Son Vice President of Vietnam National University Hanoi

On June 7th, 2019, the Prime Minister of the Socialist Republic of Vietnam signed a decision on the conditional appointment of Assoc. Prof. Dr. Pham, Bao Son to become the Vice president of

Vietnam National University Hanoi (VNU). Assoc. Prof. Dr. Pham, Bao Son previously served as the Vice rector of University of Engineering and Technology, VNU (VNU-UET) for three years (2016 – 2019); Vice director of Information technology institute, VNU (2012 – 2016); Dean of faculty of information technology, VNU-UET (2012 -2016); Deputy head of human machine interaction laboratory (2008 – 2009).

Assoc. Prof. Dr. Pham, Bao Son received his BS in Information Technology (computer science) with the university medal in 2001 and his PhD in Information Technology (computer science and engineering) in 2006 at University of New South Wales, Australia. In 2012, he was awarded with the title of Associate Professor.

His research specializes in Artificial Intelligent, knowledge acquisition, robotics and natural language processing. His works had contributed greatly to the development of science and technology in Vietnam, especially in the area of natural language processing. Assoc. Prof. Dr. Pham, Bao Son and his team had successfully developed Vietnam's very first Vietnamese language processing system.

Assoc. Prof. Dr. Pham, Bao Son's devotion and commitment to teaching and researching had made him the first Vietnamese to receive the IBM Faculty Award in 2010, Golden Globe Award in Information Technology in 2007 and Certificate of Merit from the Minister of Education and Training ministry for many years.
